

Whether it's the fantastic year-round birding, folks enjoying the summer sun at the beach, or a festive parade, there's always something going on in Brownsville. This fun and friendly border town are a little bit Mexican and a little bit American, giving it a unique character of its own. One of the ways this is expressed is the annual events in Brownsville, including the Charro Days Fiesta and the Latin Jazz Festival. Discover many of Brownsville's fun events below.

February

Charro Days Fiesta

February 20 – March 2, 2025

The Charro Days Fiesta in Brownsville is an annual community celebration of the town's rich cultural heritage. The festival typically starts at the end of February and ends in March.



Sombrero Festival February 27 – March 1, 2025

It includes various contests, including the "Frijolympics" (a bean cook-off), a parade, a carnival, music, and plenty of fun.

It takes place during Charro Days at the end of February.

April

Girls Night Out Bingo The Children's Museum

May

Lunada Artisan Market

Every 3rd Saturday of May - September, 2025

Join us every 3rd Saturday from May to September at Linear Park in the Mitte Cultural District (E. 6th St. and E. Ringgold St.) for an evening open-air Artisan Market! This family-friendly event is the perfect opportunity to support local artisans, savor delicious eats, and connect with your community. Enjoy live entertainment, a free outdoor movie projected on a big screen, and a vibrant atmosphere under the stars.

Bring a lawn chair or blanket, and feel free to bring your leashed pets—just clean up after them—while celebrating community, culture, and creativity. Gringo De Mayo May 3rd, 2025



Celebrate with live music, avocadoinspired dishes, beer, and flavored margarita samples (while supplies last), crafted by local restaurants and bars. These establishments will also compete for the best avocado dish and tequila cocktail, adding an exciting twist to the festivities.

Gringo de Mayo began as a playful tradition inspired by our late friend Jeff "Lightning" Lewis. Years ago, Jeff convinced the Brownsville Beerfest founders to host an event on Cinco de Mayo to promote the annual Beerfest. To everyone's surprise, Jeff revealed it was also his birthday, jokingly calling it "Gringo de Mayo." His clever prank and infectious spirit turned into a cherished tradition that continues to bring the community together.

Brew at the Zoo May 13th, 2025

Brew at the Zoo is a 21+ craft beer and food fundraising event. All proceeds from the event will support the zoo's efforts to save wildlife and habitats. Happens in May of every year.

Guests will be able to sample 22 craft beers and foods from nine local restaurants across the Valley. Attendees will have the opportunity to eat a varied selection of beers and foods while listening to live music and participating in a beer pong tournament.

October

Zoofari

Zoofari is the annual fundraiser held on the grounds of the Gladys Porter Zoo. This one-night event features a live auction, silent auctions, food, music, and fun for the whole family. A fun night to spend at the zoo!



Latin Jazz Festival November 16th, 2025

Latin jazz represents a confluence of African rhythms and Latin flair, a combination that is as soulful as romantic. Listen to some of the best Latin jazz performers at the Latin Jazz Festival in Brownsville, held in mid-October.



Local, regional, and world-class acts headline the three-day festival, featuring dance performances and art shows.



Brownsville Beerfest October 8th, 2025

Happening on the first Saturday of October. Our Beerfest is a nonprofit organization created in 2013 to promote our city by producing a quality-of-life event for its community and neighboring towns in the Rio Grande Valley and Northern Mexico.





November

Holiday Village Nov. 20th, 2025 - Jan. 1st, 2026

Celebrate the start of the holiday season at Brownsville's Holiday Village! Stroll through Dean Porter Park from November to the end of December, and you'll see adorable scaled-down cottages lit up just for the holiday season. Performances from dance, choir, and mariachi groups are held throughout the event. Admission to the Holiday Village is free, but the memories are priceless.

Active Discoveries

Nestled at the crossroads of two nations and surrounded by fertile farmland and tropical wildlife refuges, this vibrant city has evolved from a historic battleground to an outdoor enthusiast's dream.

Cruise along palm-lined bike trails, wander through lush tropical forests in search of rare bird species, or dive into the stories of events that helped shape America. Whether you're pedaling through scenic paths or trekking through nature's beauty, Brownsville offers countless ways to explore, discover, and experience its unique charm. Grab your bike or hiking boots and let the adventure begin!

Ride Brownsville's Bike Trails

Discover South Texas' tropical beauty by hitting the bike trails in Brownsville, a paradise for cyclists of all kinds. With 64 miles of paved and off-road trails, plus on-street bike lanes, there's plenty to explore. Among the highlights is the Brownsville Historic Battlefield Trail, a nationally recognized nine-mile paved path that stretches from downtown Brownsville to the Palo Alto Battlefield. Lined with palm trees, the trail takes you past local gems like the Gladys Porter Zoo and the Brownsville Museum of Fine Art while buzzing with joggers and fellow bikers.

For a more adventurous ride, check out the Monte Bella Bike Trail, a 6.2-mile route with winding paths and gentle climbs perfect for both beginners and seasoned mountain bikers. This spot, just northwest of Brownsville, is popular for hiking and jogging too, so stay alert on the trails.

Want even more? Head to Resaca de la Palma State Park to explore eight miles of multi-use trails in one of Brownsville's prime birding locations. No bike? No problem bike rentals are available on-site, so you can immerse yourself in the park's lush scenery.

Take a Walk Through History

Step into the stories that shaped America's history right here in Brownsville. In 1846, the first battle of the Mexican-American War unfolded on these grounds, setting the stage for the future of two nations. Fast forward to 1865, and the final clash of the Civil War took place at Palmito Ranch, just east of the city.

Begin your journey at the Palo Alto Battlefield National Historic Site, just north of Brownsville. Stroll the battlegrounds, explore the visitor center's interactive exhibits, and uncover how strategy, courage, and circumstance shaped the war's outcome. Over at Palmito Ranch, a historical marker and observation platform give you a front-row seat to the site of the Civil War's last stand.

Brownsville's rich history doesn't end there. Visit the Historic Brownsville Museum, housed in a stunning 1928 Spanish-style building, to dive deeper into the town's vibrant past. Explore other gems like the Stillman House Museum and the Old City Cemetery Center, dating back to the 1850s. Many of these sites are nestled in the Mitte Cultural District, a charming hub of museums and parks in downtown Brownsville.

BREATHTAKING

Brownsville's great outdoors offers a playground for nature lovers and adventure seekers alike. With 128 acres of parkland, scenic marinas, and 4.1 miles of picturesque resacas, the city is a haven for outdoor exploration.

The 7 miles of paved hike and bike trails weave through the city, offering stunning views and a chance to enjoy the vibrant landscapes. Add in playgrounds and other amenities, and you've got endless opportunities for fun and discovery. Whether you're biking, hiking, or just soaking in the scenery, Brownsville's trail system is a breath of fresh air.

For music lovers, the Brownsville Latin Jazz Festival in October offers three days of unforgettable performances


Find Your Flock

Birding in Brownsville is a destination-worthy adventure. With its mild climate, lush tropical setting, and prime location on a major migratory path, this riverside town hosts up to 500 tropical bird species year-round. Here, you'll find birds that can't be spotted anywhere else in the country, making it a must-visit for birding enthusiasts.

Top birding spots include Resaca de la Palma State Park, Sabal Palm Sanctuary, and Boca Chica Beach. However, the crown jewel is the Laguna Atascosa Wildlife Refuge. Home to over 400 bird speciesby world-class musicians. Meanwhile, beer enthusiasts can head to the Brownsville Beer Fest, also in October, to sample craft and specialty brews from around the globe at the impressive "longest bar in Texas," stretching an incredible 121 feet.


